

Dirk Bontinck studied Chemistry at the Ghent University, receiving a Master's Degree in 1982. He started his PhD on the total synthesis of 4-hydroxy-indol as a precursor for β -blockers Pindolol and Mepindolol. These are important Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients against cardiovascular diseases. After receiving his PhD in 1987 he joined UCB in Drogenbos, Belgium as Laboratory Manager for Polyurethanes. Starting out with Thermoplastic Polyurethanes, followed by water based polyurethane dispersions and UV curable polyurethane dispersions. He moved through several positions within R&D, from R&D Director Radcure to R&D Director Specialty Urethanes. After UCB Chemicals was taken over by Cytec in 2005, he became Global R&D Director Radcure. When Cytec Coating Resins became Allnex in 2013, he was appointed Senior Business Technology Director. Current responsibilities are for the global Analytical labs at Allnex, the Knowledge Management Office as well as managing external collaborations.
